## Calling all artists! Enter the Denton Public Library Card Design Contest. Your artwork might be featured on a special, limited edition library card.

### Rules for entry:

- All submissions must be created on the template supplied by the Library. It is available at the library and on our website at [library.cityofdenton.com](http://library.cityofdenton.com)
- The contest is open to school aged children from K—12th grade. **There will be three age categories with one winner for each: 4-8, 9-13, and 14-17 years old**
- Only one entry is allowed per person, and the person must either live in the City of Denton, attend Denton ISD or have a full Service Denton Public Library Card
- Each submission must be the creative and original work of a single individual and free of copyright restrictions
- Words may be incorporated only as graphic elements
- Submissions may be in any art medium (pencil, pen, paint, crayon, etc)
- Design suggestions: Libraries, Reading, Denton Community

**All entries must be submitted to any Denton Public Library branch, or scanned (300 dpi) and emailed to [library@cityofdenton.com](mailto:library@cityofdenton.com) by 5 p.m. on May 1, 2021.**

Submission implies full release of all rights to the submitted artwork. No late entries will be accepted. Denton Public Library reserves the right to deny entry to any submission deemed inappropriate due to the use of derogatory language or imagery, use of copyrighted materials (including cartoons, excerpts from books, etc.). Library staff may modify winning artwork to meet print requirements. The artist's name will appear on the back of the Library card.

A committee of city staff and community members involved in the arts will determine the winning design. The three winning designs will be printed on library cards and made available to Denton Public Library patrons in the summer of 2021. Winner's names and photos may appear in newspapers, on the Library's website, and in other communication.
