iPAD POLICY

All library locations provide a collection of iPads for interior use, designated for use by specific age groups.

The Library reserves the right to terminate use of an iPad at any time if a library employee believes the iPad has been used in violation of policies or used in a manner likely to damage the machine. The Library also reserves the right to refuse use of an iPad to any person who has damaged library equipment in the past or used equipment in violation of Denton Public Library policies. Library customers are bound by the Texas Penal Code, sections 43.21, 43.22, and 43.24 which make display of obscene materials a criminal offense.

USAGE PERIODS AND AVAILABILITY

iPads are available on a first come, first served basis during library hours and no reservations are permitted. iPads are for use inside the library only.

LIMITATIONS OF USE

- iPad use is subject to the Denton Public Library Internet Use Policy.
- iPads should not be removed from their cases or their designated use areas.
- Customers should not tamper with the security settings or software on the iPad. Doing so may result in loss of library privileges.
- Personal software should not be downloaded to the iPad and no user files shall be retained in its memory.
- Customers should not add, modify, or delete apps from the iPad.
