WIRELESS INTERNET (WI-FI) POLICY

Reviewed by the Library Management Team, December 14, 2022

POLICY STATEMENT: The Denton Public Library provides free Wi-Fi access which customers can use to connect to the Internet. To use this service, customers must agree to abide by relevant library policies and rules, including but not limited to, the Internet and Computer Use Policy. Wi-Fi users are bound by the Texas Penal Code, sections 43.21, 43.22, and 43.24, which make display of obscene materials a criminal offense.

The library's Wi-Fi network is not secure. The library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment, device configurations, security, or data files when connecting to the library's Wi-Fi network. The library is not responsible for any loss of data, or for theft or damage to personal equipment or software. Anti-virus and security protection are the responsibility of the customer.

Due to the diversity of devices used by customers, library staff is not able to provide technical assistance and is not permitted to configure or troubleshoot a customer's device.

Though the network is designed to cover the entire library, no guarantee is made for signal strength or availability. There is no time limit on using the Wi-Fi network with personal equipment.
